Comment: Sufficient water information not submitted. Please see the comment from the Division of Water Resources. This comment will need to be resolved before this case can go to hearing.

Response: The Division of Water Resources letter dated March 25, 2025 to Lia Campbell states that because of Adams County minimum 300-year useful life of the water supply versus the State's 100-year useful life of the water supply and the annual demand for a single-family dwelling and home/garden/lawn irrigation, we cannot drill into the Lower Arapahoe Aquifer. We would be required to drill into the Laramie-Fox Hill Aquifer resulting in tripling the cost of the well. It is our understanding that Adams County is discussing reducing the annual demand for indoor/outdoor residential usage so this issue is still pending. We are waiting for a response from Nick Eagleson.

PLN02 - Comment: Site plan needs to show setbacks of existing buildings to new lot line.

Response: The site plan has been revised to show the setbacks of the existing buildings to the new lot line. Revised site plan is attached.




Fig. 1. Some 11 4-30'



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

express or implied, relating to the subject matter of this Commitment.

- (d)The deletion or modification of any Schedule B, Part II—Exception does not constitute an agreement or obligation to provide coverage beyond the terms and provisions of this Commitment or the Policy.
- (e) Any amendment or endorsement to this Commitment must be in writing and authenticated by a person authorized by the Company.
- (f) When the Policy is issued, all liability and obligation under this Commitment will end and the Company's only liability will be under the Policy.

7. IF THIS COMMITMENT HAS BEEN ISSUED BY AN ISSUING AGENT

The issuing agent is the Company's agent only for the limited purpose of issuing title insurance commitments and policies. The issuing agent is not the Company's agent for the purpose of providing closing or settlement services.

8. PRO-FORMA POLICY
