ROADSIDE MEMORIAL SIGNAGE PROGRAM CRITERIA

We want to first and foremost send our condolences to those impacted by this tragedy. We hope this program provides comfort and remembrance of loved one(s).

Some important information to follow as you fill out this application. Memorial signs may be requested only by the immediate family of the victim or by close friends when no immediate family members are available.

The program applies only to fatal crashes occurring on a county road in unincorporated Adams County. For state highway traffic fatalities, an applicant may contact the **Colorado Department of Transportation at 303.757.9662**. It is important to note that only one memorial sign will be installed or issued per crash. Up to three names may be included on one sign if there are multiple victims.

The applicant shall pay Adams County \$100 due upon approval of the application. This fee is in place to cover partial expenses for creating, installing, and maintaining the sign.

The sign will be maintained by Adams County Public Works Department and remain in place for two years from the date of initial installation. At the conclusion of the posting period, the sign will be retired by the Public Works Department and returned to the applicant.

Additional special requirements for “don’t drink and drive” signs for fatal alcohol/drug related crashes:

There must be a conviction of the responsible driver involved in the fatal crash who was in violation of Colorado’s DUI laws, or a toxicology report showing the driver to have been in violation of Colorado’s DUI laws. Note: An intoxicated driver who died does not qualify as a victim in this program.
