- Behavioral Health-Commissioner Emma Pinter: Working on the competency evaluation process along with tracking changes with the BHA on the local and state level. Subcommittee has excellent conversation and questions from behavioral health providers.
- Crime Prevention, Intervention, and Re-Entry-Sheriff Claps: Unable to attend meeting.
- Executive Committee-District Attorney Brian Mason: Director was hired for CJCC. Discussion around strategic planning and understanding 2026 needs for the CJCC.
