## SUBRECIPIENTS:

- Annual Monitoring done for all 5 subgrantees. All of them are compliant, a few recommendations and requests.
- DOLA will be monitoring 10/08/2025

On a national level, the 2026 budget proposal was shared. There are no updates within the County. CSBG staff shared that subrecipients were monitored and overall are compliant. Also discussed was the DOLA monitoring that will take place Oct. 8<sup>th</sup>.

- c) CSBG staff shared that there have been some members resigned and due to that, would like to revise bylaws so that the commitment is more feasible. A draft will be emailed to members and will then be submitted to the Board of County Commissioners.
- d) CSBG staff also talked about changing meeting days from Fridays, however members present stated Friday mornings work for them. Another point discussed was if moving to in-person was preferred and video meetings were still preferred. CSBG staff mentioned we would move to Teams, since Zoom has an annual fee. Members present said they would have no issues with Teams.
